This case came up for hearing on 14th August 2003.

Heard the counsel. He stated that the Respondent stopped the Special Scheme despite the directions of the Commission and billed him on regular tariff, which cost him Rs.8, 19,256/- extra. He pleaded that the case may be heard on merits. It was pointed out to the Counsel that the direction of the Commission, issued earlier, has been stayed by the Hon High Court in MFA No.1557/03 and the

stay is still in operation, and therefore the Commission cannot adjudicate his plea of excess billing etc..

The petition, therefore, is not admitted. Ordered accordingly.
