Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner on admission.

2. The learned Counsel stated that the Petitioner has implemented a scheme known as Hassan Growth Center Scheme and for the water supply requirement

of the project has installed electrical works costing over Rs. 1 crore, and it has to draw power to the extent of 650 kVA, from the Respondents. He submitted that he has filed the present petition with a prayer to seek waiver of Minimum power charges raised by the Respondents. The learned Counsel stated that he has approached the Commission under section 11 (a), (b), (f) and (m) of Karnataka Electricity Reforms Act, 1999.

3. The demand on the Petitioner has been made under the K.E.R.C.(E.S.& D) Code, 2000-2001, and any problems involving such demand has to be settled through the mechanism provided under the said code. Evidently the petition is misconceived and the Petitioner has to approach the proper forum to sort out its problem.

4. Hence the Petition is **not admitted**.
