Heard the learned Counsel for the Petitioner. He has also filed his written arguments about the admissibility.

2. The learned Counsel stated that the Respondent Company had violated the provisions of the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurements Act, 1999, by outsourcing the work relating to Revenue ledgers, without calling for the tenders. He pleaded that this violation can be challenged before the Commission under section 11(a) and 12 of the Karnataka Electricity Reforms Act 1999.

3. The issues raised by the petitioner pertain to the Karnataka Transparency in Public Procurements Act, 1999 and they do not fall within the purview of the K.L.R.Act, 1999, and therefore the petition is not admissible.

4. Petition does not merit admission. So ordered.
