In the matter of issue of KERC (Manner of payment of subsidy by State Government) Regulations, 2007

Pursuant to Section 65 of the Electricity Act 2003, the State Commission has to specify the manner in which the subsidy has to be paid by the State Government, in case the Government grants subsidy to any consumer or class of consumers in the tariff determined by the State Commission. In this regard, KERC had issued draft regulations on 29.10.2007, inviting comments from various stakeholders. The Commission has received comments from ten stakeholders, including the State Government. Before finalizing the regulations, the Commission has proposed to conduct a hearing in the matter on 23.01.2008 at 11.30 AM in the Court Hall of KERC, Bangalore, to elicit views from various stakeholders. Interested stakeholders/ persons may participate in the hearing and may also make written submissions in the subject matter. The Draft Regulations are available on KERC's website www.kerc.org.
