1. In this petition, the petitioner had sought for the following reliefs :
 - (1) Direct the 1st respondent corporation to pay to the petitioner a sum of Rs.70,68,029/- along with interest as per the terms of Power Purchase Agreement to the petitioner Company;
 - (2) Direct the 2nd respondent company to pay to the petitioner a sum of Rs.2,51,70,728/- as per the terms of Power Purchase Agreement along with the interest to the petitioner Company;
 - (3) Grant such other and further reliefs as this Hon'ble Commission deems fit in the facts and circumstances of the case.

2. On 2.4.2009 the Counsels appearing for both the parties submitted that they have come to a settlement in the following terms and the petition may be disposed off in these terms :

i) The respondents will abide by the PPA in force and will pay for the electricity supplied at the rate fixed in Clause 5.1 of the PPA which reads as under :

“Monthly Energy Charges: Corporation shall, for the Delivered Energy, pay, for the first 10 years from the date of signing of Agreement, to the Company every month during the period commencing from the Commercial Operation Date on the basis of the base price applicable for the year 1994-95 at the rate of Rs.2.25 (Rupees Two and twenty five paise) per kilowatt-hour (the tariff) for energy delivered to the Corporation at the Metering Point with an escalation at a rate of 5 % per annum over the tariff applicable for the previous year as per guidelines issued by the Ministry of Non-Conventional Energy Sources of the Grid.”

ii) For the amount not paid on account of non-grant of escalation as provided in Clause 5.1, the respondents will pay an interest of 6.5 % per annum.

3. Recording the above submissions this petition is disposed off.

4. Parties have to bear their costs respectively.
