1. In this petition the petitioner has made the following prayers :
 - A. The first, second and third respondents to provide wheeling and banking facility for the petitioner's SMW wind power generating unit;
 - B. The first, second and third respondents to allow wheeling and give credit to the energy generated and banked – awaiting to be wheeled from the petitioner's project after 25th September, 2009;
 - C. The second and third respondents to execute the Wheeling and Banking Agreement with the petitioner as per the approved format of the Wheeling and Banking Agreement standardized for wind projects;
 - D. The third, fourth and fifth respondents to refund the surcharge detailed in Annexure P-6 and continuing as on date and further, along with interest at bank rate from the date of collection to the date of refund to the satisfaction of the petitioner;
 - E. The first respondent to act as the single window agency for all wheeling and banking transactions right from the acceptance of the wheeling requisition in the prescribed forms up to the successful completion of wheeling;
 - F. The respondents to grant the cost of this petition; and
 - G. Pass any other order/s to meet the ends of justice and equity.

2. The facts and contentions raised and the prayers made in this petition are similar to those in OP No.50/2009 M/s. RPG Cables Vs. KPTCL and others which has been disposed of on 6.1.2011. Accordingly this petition is disposed of following the said order in the same terms.
