**ORDERS**

- 1) In the above Review Petition, the Petitioner has prayed for revising the HT temporary power supply Tariff Order dated 21.1.2016, passed by this Commission in OP No.43/2015, by deleting the weekly minimum charges of Rs.200 (Rupees two hundred) per HP fixed therein.

- 2) In OP No.43/2015, on the request of the Petitioner to determine a separate tariff for its consumption of HT temporary power for conducting Industrial Exhibition and Trade Fairs at the Bangalore International Exhibition Centre (BIEC), this Commission by its Order dated 21.1.2016, had allowed the said request of the Petitioner and determined the HT temporary tariff for the Petitioner at the rate of Rs.10/- per Unit, subject to a weekly minimum of Rs.200/- per HP. The above tariff was ordered to be effective till the next revision of the retail supply tariff.
- 3) The next revision of the retail supply tariff has been made by this Commission by Order dated 30.3.2016 with effect from 1.4.2016. During the revision of the retail supply tariff, the power supply availed on temporary basis with the contract demand of 67 HP and above by the Petitioner is treated as a separate category, viz., HT-5(a) Temporary Supply, and the tariff is fixed at 1050 paise per Unit towards the energy charges, without imposing any Fixed Demand charges.
- 4) The Petitioner has filed the present Review Petition on 15.2.2016, before the Tariff Order dated 30.3.2016 revising the retail supply tariff. The request made by the Petitioner, in the Review Petition, is therefore met with in the revised retail supply tariff Order dated 30.3.2016. Therefore, the Review Petition does not survive.

5) For the foregoing reasons, we pass the following :

**ORDER**

The Review Petition is dismissed.
