
In the matter of the revision of time allowed for commissioning of the 1MW SRTPV project in the PPA of Smt Nagarathamma .N. located at Sy No: 146/P49, 146/P34 & 146/P35, Nagareddyhalli Village, Mulabagil Taluk, Kolar District.


1. Whereas, the Commission has approved the PPA executed with Bangalore Electricity Supply Company Limited (BESCOM) on 05.02.2016 in respect of **1MW** SRTPV project on existing rooftop of the building belonging to Smt Nagarathamma .N. located at Sy No: 146/P49, 146/P34 & 146/P35, Nagareddyhalli Village, Mulabagil Taluk, Kolar District (hereinafter referred to as 'SRTPV Consumer').
2. Whereas, while approving the said PPA, a period of one year was erroneously allowed for installing and commissioning the SRTPV plant on the existing roof top instead of six months as was allowable in such cases.
3. Whereas, in order to set right the error, the Commission has, vide its Notice dated 29.08.2016, had called upon the SRTPV consumer to show cause as to why the period of one year should not be revised to six months. Similar notice was also given to BESCOM.
4. Whereas, in reply to the said Notice the SRTPV consumer has furnished reply as follows:
 - a. Her agreement for installation of SRTPV system is specifically for proposed rooftop / under construction building.
 - b. Substantial progress has been made in ground work/preparation, mobilization of funds, purchase of materials and financial commitments.


- c. The SRTPV plant may be allowed to be completed as per the time stipulated and agreed period of 1 year.
5. Whereas, BESCOM has not furnished any reply to the Commission's Notice.
6. The Commission notes that, contrary to the statement made in the reply furnished by the SRTPV consumer, as per PPA and also the Detailed Project Report furnished the SRTPV plant was to be installed on an existing roof of Polyhouses.
7. The Commission found that the SRTPV consumer had an existing rooftop for installation and commissioning of the SRTPV plant and was entitled to only six months time for installing and commissioning of the SRTPV plant from the date of PPA. Hence the following ,

ORDER

1. The action as proposed in the Notice dated 26th August, 2016 is hereby confirmed.
2. If, the SRTPV Consumer completes the project after the approved time of six months, the said consumer will be entitled to the tariff as determined in the Commission's Order dated 2nd May, 2016.
