

## CHAPTER – 10

### PRAYER FOR LEAVE OF THE COMMISSION

BESCOM with averments made above and various issues highlighting revenue requirement of the licensee respectfully prays the Hon'ble Commission may please approve the following:

- Truing up of FY-21 based on audited accounts.
- The unmet revenue gap is Rs. 4609.56 Crs. (Rs.2185.29 Crs. For FY-21 and Rs.2424.27 Crs. For FY-23) for FY-23 and allow the licensee to hike the average tariff by 1.58 paise across all the categories. The additional revenue through tariff approximately works out to Rs. 4609.56 Crs.
- BESCOM has proposed to Reduce fixed charges to domestic consumers below 5 KW, to increase Demand charges for HT consumers and to discontinue the Special Incentive Scheme and Discounted Energy Rate Scheme for HT consumers if demand charges are increased for HT consumers.

The revised tariff is submitted in D-20 format.
