**O R D E R**

The Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Ltd (hereinafter referred to as KPTCL) is a Transmission Licensee, under the provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003. KPTCL has filed its application on 30<sup>th</sup> November, 2017, under the provisions of the KERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations 2006, has prayed for, among other things, to approve its actual ARR and Revenue gap for FY17 based on the audited annual accounts and to carry over the revenue gap of FY17 to the ARR of FY19 for recovery from the ESCOMs from 01.04.2018.

In exercise of the powers conferred under Sections 62 and 64 and other provisions of the Electricity Act, 2003 and the KERC (Tariff) Regulations, 2000 read with the KERC (Terms and Conditions for Determination of Transmission Tariff) Regulations 2006, and other enabling Regulations, the Commission has considered the application of the KPTCL and also the views and objections submitted by the consumers and other stakeholders. The item-wise analysis, review and the Commission's decisions thereon are brought out in the subsequent chapters of this Order.
